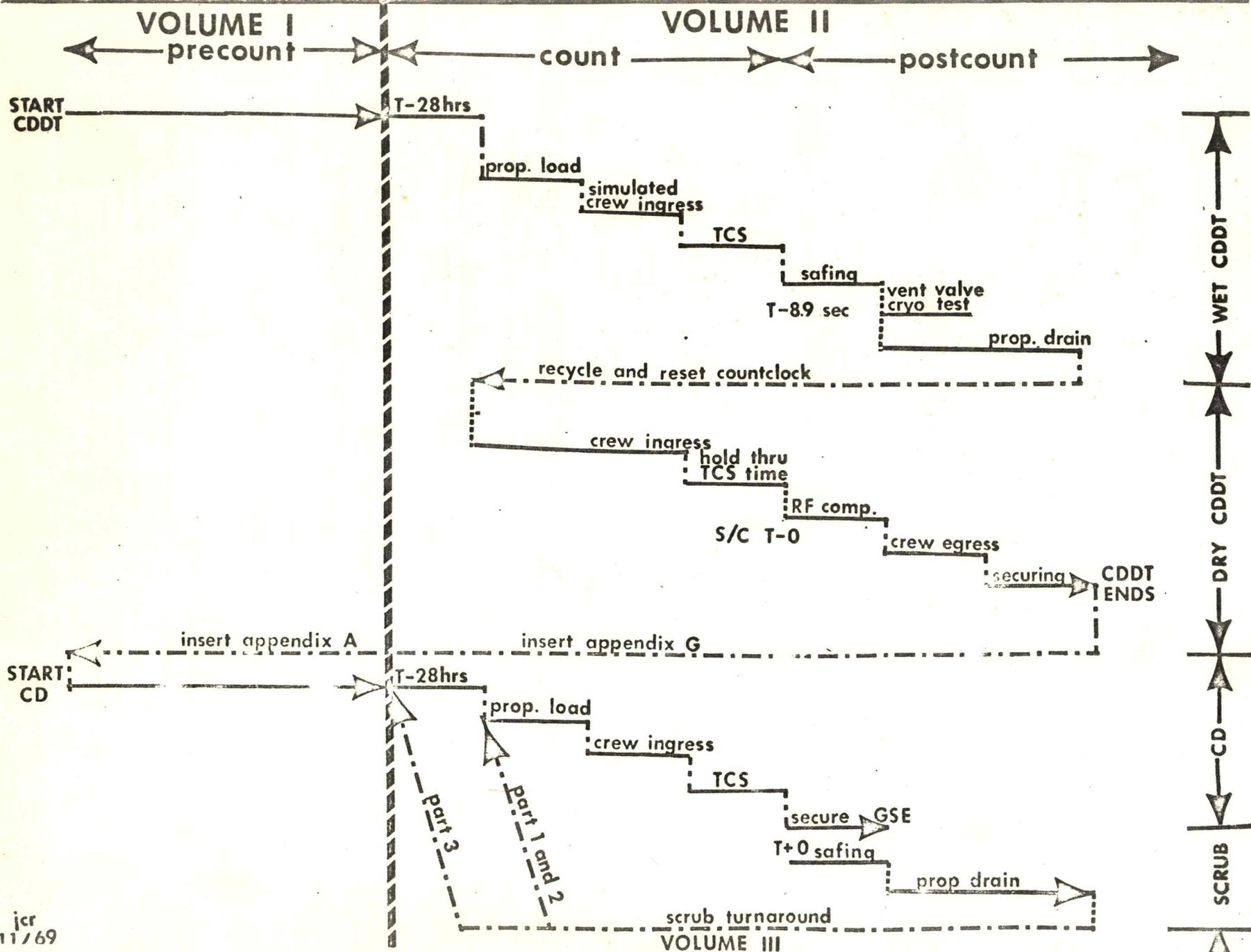

The wet countdown demonstration will be performed the same as the launch countdown with the following major exceptions: Hypergol cartridges, igniters, initiators, safe and arm devices and exploding bridge wire detonators will be inert; DRSCS test code plugs will be used instead of flight code plugs; the service arm and tail service mast pressure hold test will be performed; jumpers will be installed to inhibit retraction of service arms 1 & 2; astronauts will not enter the spacecraft; and TCS will be interrupted at time for ignition.			
The dry countdown demonstration will be the same as the last 3 1/2 hours of the launch countdown with the following major exceptions: LV cryogenic propellants, and the radioisotope thermal generator will not be on board; the primary damper and service arms 1 through 8 will not be retracted; and service arm 9 will be extended and reconnected as soon as the system has stabilized in the park position.

<p>This procedure includes launch vehicle operations for both the Countdown Demonstration Test and Countdown. It is divided into three volumes.</p> <p>Volume I covers launch vehicle precount operations. Volume II covers launch vehicle count operations as well as safing and securing operations. Volume III includes operations necessary to recycle the launch vehicle for another launch window.</p> <p>1. <u>Radio Frequency Systems</u>: All RF systems will be functionally checked out by ground stations and the RF checkout equipment. The MSS will be in place and passive repeaters will be connected to the various systems through antenna couplers. All stage command destruct systems will be checked. Antenna couplers will be removed prior to removal of the MSS after all systems have been validated and turned off. The C-band transponder, and the CCS will be turned off after validation. All RF systems will be turned on prior to launch and will again be interrogated and performance evaluated at the ground stations, the RF checkout station, and by correlation of these sources with the digital data acquisition system.</p> <p>2. <u>Telemetry Systems</u>: The telemetry systems will be turned on from the LCC measuring and RF panels and parameter checks conducted by the CIF ground station. Following these checks, the system will be used as required.</p> <p>3. <u>Measurement System</u>: The measurement system will be verified after verification of the telemetry systems. The verification will primarily be performed under programmed control of the 110A computer.</p> <p>4. <u>Guidance, Control and Stabilized Platform</u>: Functional tests of the guidance control and stabilized platform (GC&SP) system will be conducted. These tests will: (a) visually verify system configuration, (b) run automatic turn-on procedures early in the countdown and (c) verify subsystem operation.</p> <p>The flight computer subsystem checks include a repeatable simulated flight sequence, system interface test sequence (discrete check), and L/V steering tests.</p> <p>The control computer nulls will be checked for acceptable values during warmup before the vehicle prelaunch checks are made.</p> <p>The ST-124M stabilized platform subsystem will be checked. The automatic long range theodolite true azimuth will be re-established using the reference benchmark and the theodolite system will be functionally tested before ST-124M platform tests are run.</p>					<p>The combined GC & SP will be brought to an operating condition to support the space vehicle power transfer test and operation on internal power will be verified to be acceptable. A few hours before T-0, the long range theodolite system will be set up to maintain the ST-124M platform azimuth alignment. The platform will be powered-up, aligned to the launch azimuth and held there until guidance release. In the final minutes of countdown, the combined GC & SP system will be utilized in the stage steering tests. These will be run on the S-IVB stage, then the S-II stage and finally the S-IC stage just before the terminal count sequence.</p> <p>5. <u>Networks</u>: The networks countdown activities include performance of electrical support equipment (ESE) preparation in the launch umbilical tower (LUT) and pad terminal connection room (PTCR) prior to evacuation of those areas.</p> <p>Preparations of the LUT ESE will include performing bus resistance checks from the LUT power distributors to the stage bus line before applying vehicle power. The various power and control distributors will be inspected for proper cable connections and switch positions. A check will be made to ensure that all cables are clear of movable mechanisms. Final checks will be made of recorder calibration digital events evaluator (DEE) operation and sequencer operation under launch control center (LCC) control. Associated indications at the LCC will be checked against existing conditions in the LUT. Preparations of a similar nature will be given to the PTCR ESE with emphasis on propellant and gases, electrical equipment and data transmission system.</p> <p>The LCC ESE preparations will be performed in conjunction with and following those in the LUT & PTCR. The will consist of visual inspection of power, instrumentation, and control distributors for proper cable connections and switch positions. Patch panel connections to the recorders and between the firing room and the PTCR will be visually inspected. Final recorder calibrations will be completed together with checks on the DEE printout devices.</p> <p>Power transfer tests will be conducted early in the count with final power transfer initiated late in the count. Proper transfer and correct vehicle battery loading will be verified. Late in the count, approximately T-5 minutes, the terminal countdown and ignition sequencers will be armed in preparation for the automatic terminal sequence start of T-3 minutes 7 seconds.</p> <p>6. <u>Emergency Detection System</u>: The EDS will be functionally tested after final power up and again shortly before T-0. The ground computer will program simulated malfunctions of input parameters and verify proper voting of the EDS logic units.</p>

<p>7. <u>Propellants</u>: The LOX & LH2 systems will be prepared for tanking during precount operations. Valves will be prepositioned and electrical controls checked. Propellant loading sensors will be checked and the propellants tanking computer system tested. During CDDT, an actual cryogenic propellant loading will be performed. Following the terminal count sequence, an S-II LH2 vent valve cryogenic test will be conducted and the propellants will be drained.</p> <p>8. <u>Propulsion</u>: The propulsion system launch countdown operations will be a direct continuation of the precount operation.
