

Sitterson Hall Dedication

Dedication ceremonies for J. Carlyle Sitterson Hall will be held on University Day, October 12, 1987. An open house for University faculty, staff, and alumni will be held on Sunday, October 11.

Sitterson Hall is designed to provide sophisticated communication support for the education and research programs of the Computer Science Department. It is equipped to handle video and integrated voice-data signals and is wired with fiber optic and coaxial cables. Six interconnected local area networks link close to 100 graphic workstations to support the research efforts of the Department's 120 full-time graduate students.

The building's 74,000 square feet provide space for offices, two teleclassrooms, several conference areas, and six laboratories: the Microelectronic Systems Lab, the Microelectronics Design Lab, the Graphics and Image Processing Lab, the Communications Research Lab, the Natural Language and Text Processing Lab, and the Software Systems Lab.
