## WHAT DOES THE WOMEN'S CENTER DO?

The Women's Center empowers women and girls by providing them opportunities to grow, learn new skills and give support to one another. At The Women's Center, women and girls have access to quality legal services, financial and career counseling, adolescent programming, community resources and emergency assistance.



#### **LEGAL SERVICES**

We provide answers to your legal questions and arm you with the information and resources you need to tackle your legal issues.

- Free 15-minute phone appointment with an attorney or free 30-minute in-person appointment with a UNC law student provides you with legal information.
- Our family law book gives you legal information about separation, divorce, domestic violence, child custody, and property settlement. Available in English or Spanish.

#### FINANCIAL COUNSELING

We help you manage your money, save to buy a home and overcome any credit/debt issues you might have through our Community Financial Counseling program.

 Financial counseling can help you budget your money and meet your financial goals.

#### CAREER COUNSELING

We provide you with the job search skills to land a job through our career counseling program New Choices. . . Strategies for Success.

 Individual career counseling helps you with your resume and interviewing skills, advises you on the job search or helps you explore a career direction.



### SUPPORT GROUPS AND WORKSHOPS

We teach you skills and help you find other women to connect with as you experience life changes through our workshops and support groups in the areas of personal growth, legal issues, career, health, finances, and women's issues.

#### ADOLESCENT PROGRAMS

We teach girls life skills and critical thinking to guide and help them make good decisions now and in the future through our adolescent programs.

- Teens Climb High (TCH) is an empowerment program for middle school girls from low-income families in Chapel Hill and Carrboro.
   TCH provides girls with support to make positive life choices and avoid teen pregnancy. The program includes afterschool group sessions, mentoring, enrichment activities and case management.
- M.A.G.I.C (Media Analysis of Gender and Image Construction), a media literacy program for girls and boys, gives participants the skills to evaluate media messages related to gender, body image, violence, money, and relationships. Staff is available to provide programming for schools and community groups and to train educators.

#### Directions from Durham:

Take 15-501 S towards Chapel Hill. Take the Franklin St. exit. Stay on Franklin St. for about 3 miles. Look for the Morehead Planetarium on the left. After passing the Planetarium, take a right at the stoplight onto Henderson St. Cross Rosemary St. After Rosemary St., the Center is the 2nd building on the right. A two-story, tan house.

#### Directions from Raleigh:

Take I-40 West. Take exit 270 (15-501 South, to the right of the exit ramp). Continue with directions above.

#### **Directions from Hillsborough:**

Take 1-40 East. Take exit 260 (Hwy 86/ Airport Rd., exit ramp to the right). Stay on Airport Rd. until you get to Rosemary St. Take a left onto Rosemary St. At the next stoplight, take a left on Henderson St.
