## KOREA

1. Little change in ground situation—The situation in the Korean front lines remained largely unchanged during the past 24 hours while North Korean forces continued to press the attack along the south coast and in the Waegwan area. In the south, elements of the US 25th Division succeeded through limited counterattacks in regaining ground west of Masan which was lost during the previous day. In the center sector, six miles south of Tuksong, enemy forces were able to reinforce their bridgehead on the east bank of the Naktong River. Also in this sector, US forces are attempting to reduce enemy units which have infiltrated behind the US 27th Regiment and are cutting its communication line. There was little activity in the other ground sectors or by air and sea units.
