1. Enclosed are copies of letters addressed to the American Minister, Mr. Moffat, by the Department of External Affairs, Canada. These letters are more or less self-explanatory and serve to indicate the manner in which the United States Army Canol Project in Canada is being conducted by its representative, Colonel Theodore Wyman, C. E.

2. Unofficially Canadian Offices have reported more than once of the high-handed manner in which Colonel Wyman has conducted himself in Canada. And, during the visit of Mr. Moffat and the undersigned to the Canadian Northwest different people including high officers of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police spoke disparagingly of this officer. This is indeed unfortunate. Unless something is done to correct this situation it is the opinion of this office that the Canadian Government may see fit to request the recall of Colonel Wyman.

3. The contents of the enclosures were communicated to the State Department by Mr. Moffat.

I. This investigation is conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Army Regulations governing the investigation of the activities of persons connected with the Army.
