

frequently in previous correspondence, no development within reason will be in eventual excess in view of the planned great expansion of naval aviation in this area.

6. Earliest practicable information as to Departmental action is requested.

7. By copy of this endorsement, Commander Patrol Wing TWO and Commander Aircraft Battle Force are directed to take immediate steps to develop the best arming and re-arming procedure for Patrol Wing TWO and one aircraft carrier group at Naval Air Station Pearl Harbor that can be improved with facilities and conditions as they now exist, and prior to the full corrective action requested herein. The Commandant Fourteenth Naval District is requested to cooperate in this directive.

8. The urgency of delivery of this document is such that it will not reach the addressee in time by the next available officer courier. The originator, therefore, authorizes the transmission of this document by registered mail within the continental limits of the United States.
