#### 2. Comment:

- a. This past month a large percentage of men were suffering from colds due to the unprecendented amount of rain. At present this rate is low.
- b. Our casualties this month are moderate mostly due to the clearing of road blocks which were heavely mined.
- c. Their has been no new malarial cases this month. About five cases were admitted to the hospital as recurrent malaria.
- d. Due to the fact that the battalion has been continually on the move and in combat, our veneral rate is very low, only three cases, of which two were generabea and one chancroid.
- e. Major Kyser, M.C. of Special Troops has been assigned to hold sick call every morning.
- f. Capt. Ambrey E. Stowers, M.C. left the battalion on October 10, 19th for the states on a thirty day furlough. I have assumed command of the Medical Detachment from this date.
