TPS Processing Background

- TPS turnaround requirements consist of:
 - Comprehensive post flight inspection of all components, and re-waterproofing (OMRS)
 - Removals for LRU replacement access (Windows, FRCS, Antennas, ADP, Engines, etc)
 - Deferred work, IFA's, Modifications and special Chits are mission specific
- Due to the high-volume nature of TPS, any process change can significantly affect the work content
- Significant increase in PRACA count post-Columbia
 - Average count for the 6 pre-Columbia flows was ~750 PR/DR's with 93 cavities
 - STS-121 count ~5000 PR/DR's and 352 cavities
 - STS-116 is at 1900 PR/DR's with post flight inspection at 90% complete
- Work content can be placed into Two major processing categories
 - Acreage area work affects resources
 - Critical path area work affects critical path schedule and vehicle configuration

Many Variables / Challenges to TPS Pre-Planning - Cavities are Only a Portion of Overall Work Content

Additional Work Content Requiring TPS Resources

- In addition to the *Mandatory* turnaround requirements (OMRS, Deferred work, IFA's and LRU access), the following remaining *Risk Reduction and Hardening* effort is competing for available schedule and resources
 - Gap Filler replacements (~ 5500 per vehicle)
 - BRI Tile implementation landing gear, LESS and windows (~550 tile per vehicle)
 - Lockbolt sampling (~25 100 removals)
 - Corrosion sampling (~200 removals)
 - Misc Modifications (Hub tile, Drain Hole, WLE soft goods, etc)
- Requires managing 'OMDP-type' work over multiple standard flows

Requires Detailed Prioritization and Partnering Between Orbiter and Ground Ops -- On-Going



Available TPS Resources - Increased Capability

- Additional TPS resources secured after post-Columbia (~35% increase)
 - Plan to transition TPS Techs to Vehicle after OMM was aborted
- TPS Organization formed to maximize fleet processing efficiency
- TPS resources recently further augmented authorized by Gap Filler CR (additional ~33% increase)
- Additional resources available as they are trained
 - Gap filler training ECD Sept 06
 - TPS Bonding ECD early 07

~ 80% Increase in Post-Columbia TPS Workforce to Address Increased Workload and the Risk Reduction / Hardening Effort



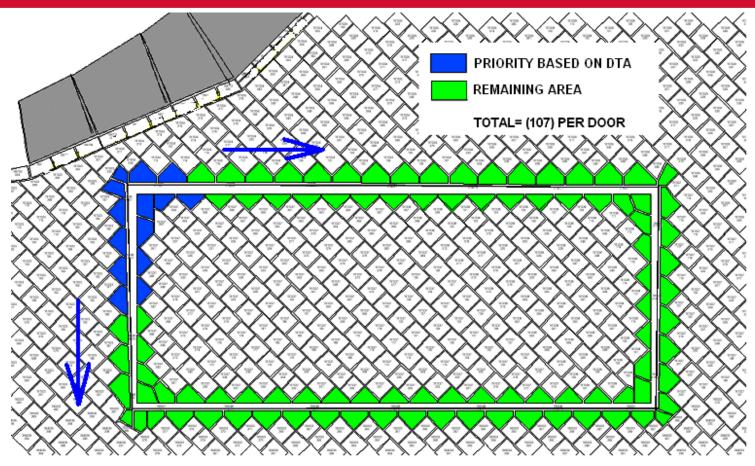
Fleet TPS Work Content Implementation Plan

- Individual-flow work content/priority to be partnered among Orbiter and Ground Ops
 - Mandatory work content scope is matured after post flight inspections
 - Risk Reduction and Hardening will be prioritized and balanced with remaining/available schedule and resources
- Final TPS work content will be baselined at the Delta Launch Site Flow Review
 - Individual-flow work content must be balanced across the Fleet/Manifest
- BRI Hardening implementation by prioritized areas balanced with available schedule windows and resources
 - Critical path considerations for landing gear areas
 - Resource and adjacent hardware configuration considerations for LESS and Window Carrier Panel areas

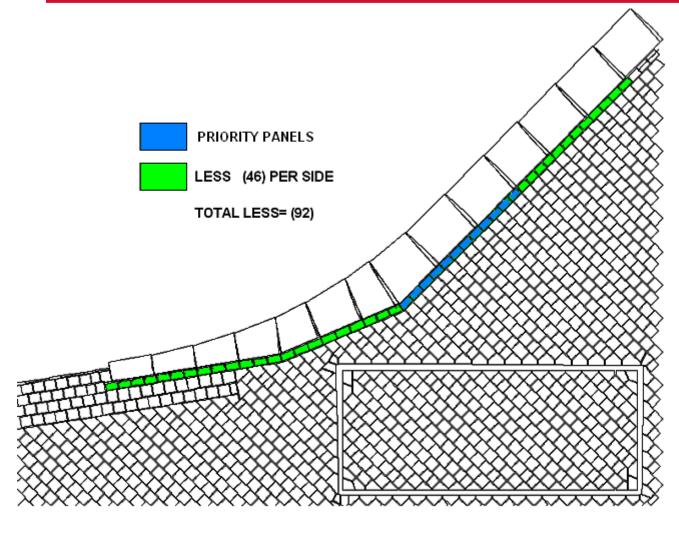

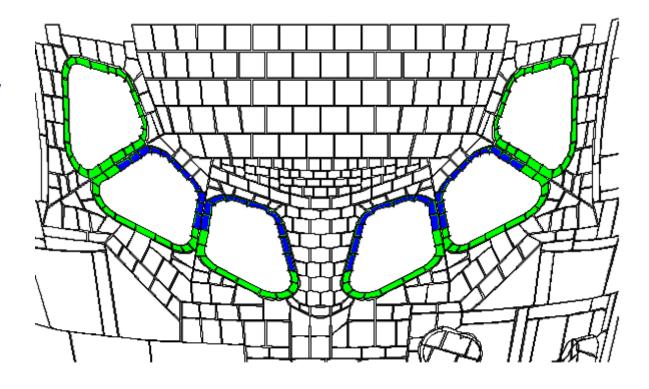

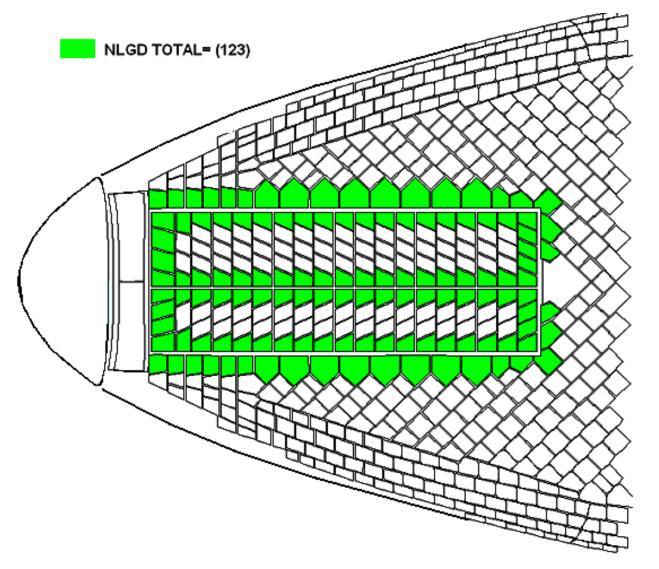

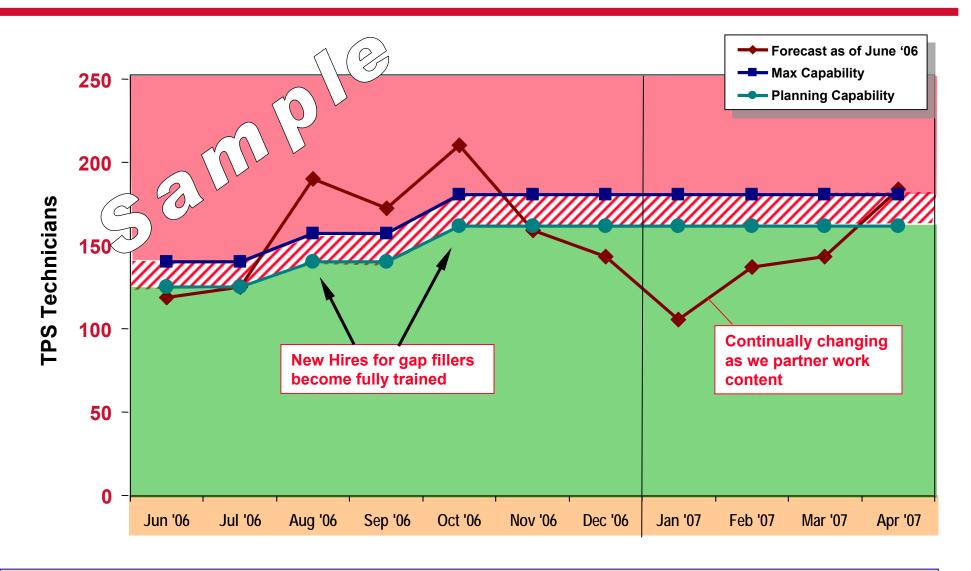

ASA & ATVC Removals

- Request authorization to not remove ASA's #2 & 4 and ATVC's #1 & 2
- Orbiter has reviewed the rationale and determined that there is a low likelihood for a smart short to occur
 - Avionics architecture design is robust to protect against random failures
 - Detailed hardware design includes layers of protection
 - Operational practices and controls minimize the potential for critical failures
 - Crit 1R2 for undetected null failure
 - Detectable during dynamic operations
 - Tested during pre-launch slew and OPS 8 aerosurface drive test (ADT)
 - Crit 1R3 for all other failures
- Revision to Chit J6106 is being processed to move the effectivity from Flt 33 to Flt 34

Item (1) M072-794500-004 IVHM Harness Installation Bay 13

- Background
- M072-794500-004 IVHM Harness Installation Bay 13 called out by MECSLSI V072-200195
- During STS-114 processing this tech order configuration called for the removal of an un-used IVHM harness along with the routing hardware.
- At the time the tech order was made a requirement for flight 31, the bay 13 longeron had already been installed for flight.
- The harness was demated and stowed in place per MR and was deferred to a future flight at which time the bay 13 longeron will be removed.
- Since the bay 13 longeron was not removed this flight, a configuration waiver is needed for STS-116.
- Recommendation
- Approve Configuration Waiver for M072-794500-004





Background

- M072-784633-014 Harness Installation-Interface Panel-MADS #3 called out by MECSLSI V072-200195
- During OMDP, the crossover bracket modification was successfully implemented at ALL FOUR locations with no technical issues by engineering defined by orbiter drawings as well as 3 tech orders (M072-794011, M072-794031, and M072-794051).
- The M072-784633-014 tech order was established to incorporate the crossover bracket modification at two of these locations (Xo863 and Xo750).
- At the Xo863 location, M072-784633-014 called for the removal of a clamp and six screws to reflect the change of harness mounting due to the new wire tray shape.
- TPS OEL-3-31-245 incorporated the electrical portion of this modification per the vehicle drawings as well as the three tank set harness tech orders. During STS-114 processing, the WAD was reviewed and it was determined that an error exists in the M072-784633 engineering.
- This tech order reflects harness routing at the Xo863 that does not reflect the as-built configuration on the orbiter, see pages 13 & 14.

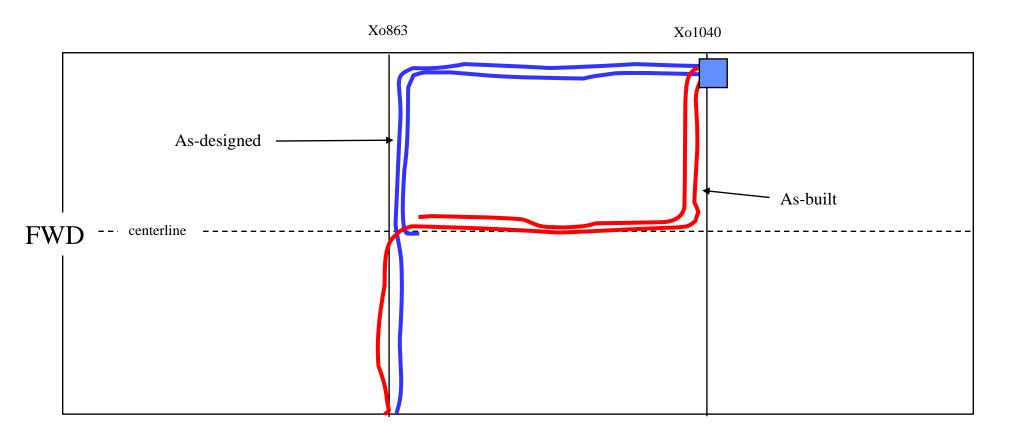

- A one flight configuration waiver was processed and approved for STS-114 and STS-121.
- All hardware on this tech order is crit level 3.
- This tech order supports MADS wire routing, there were no observed wire routing violations noted during flight 31 midbody closeout and all MADS testing will be completed and verified.
- No technical issue with hardware, installation, or function of MADS.
- There was no access to this area this flow to perform wire routing as-built condition. A configuration waiver is needed for STS-116 for this tech order.

- Approve Configuration Waiver for M072-784633-014

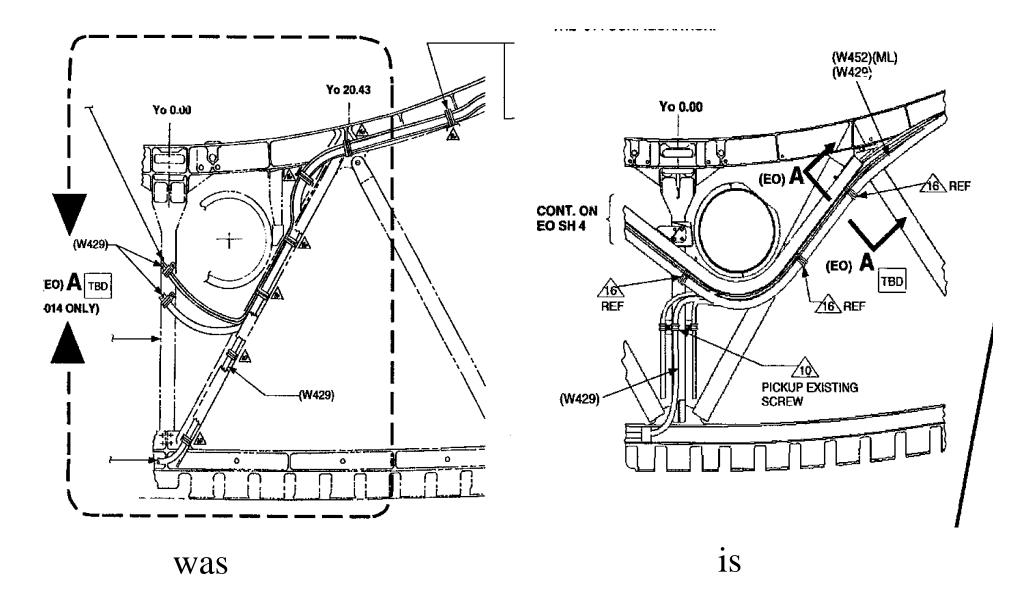

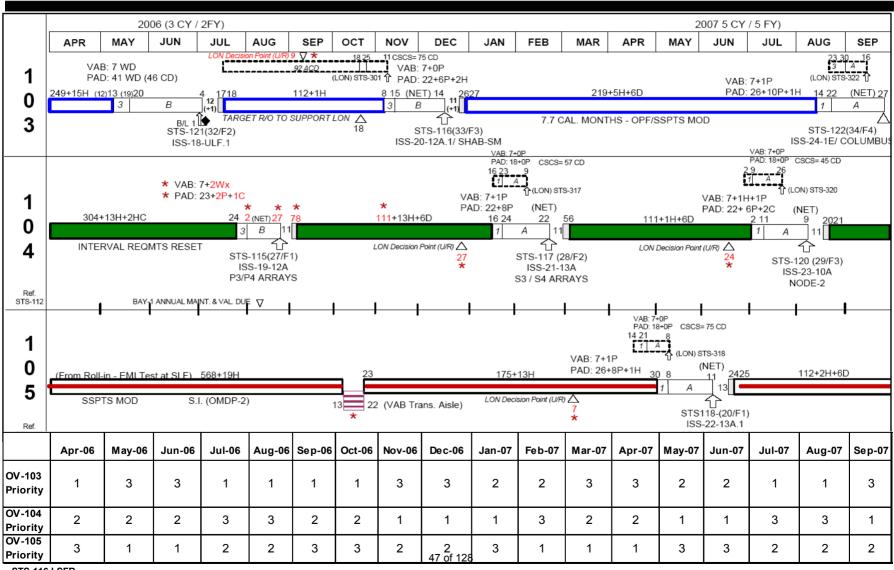
