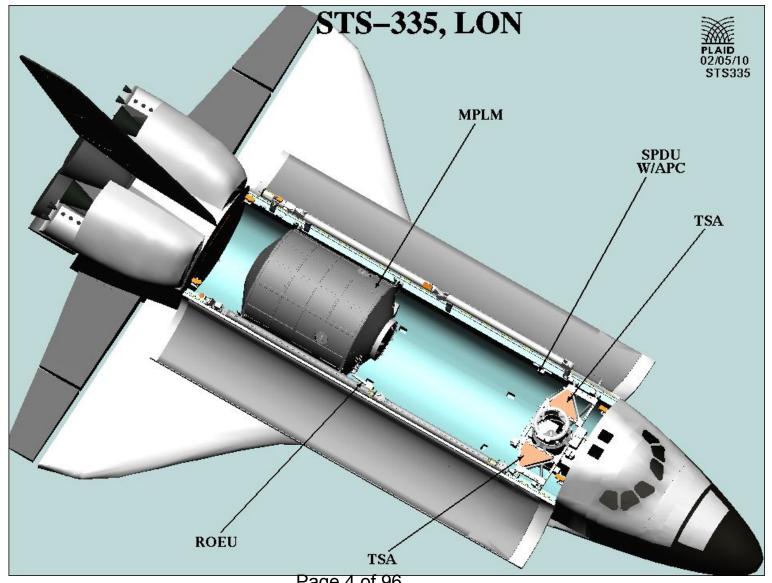

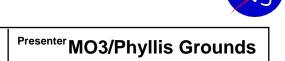

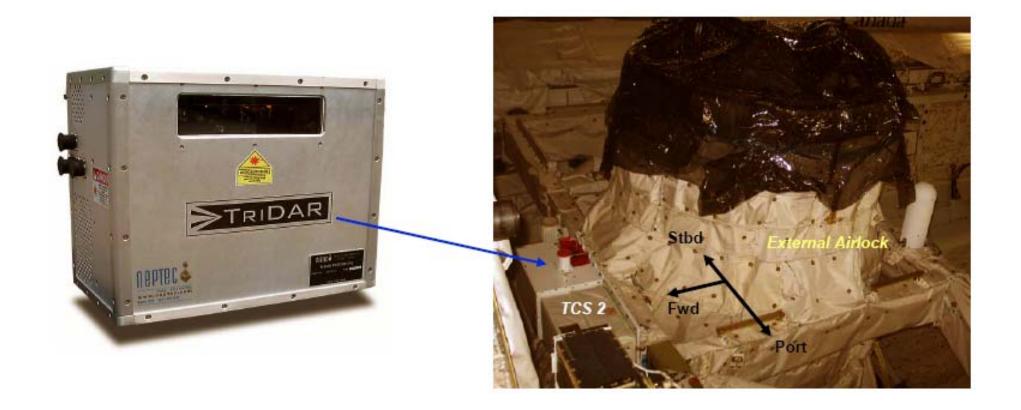
Potential Modifications

- TriDAR (GFE) Installation in Support of DTO-701A (TAD 30164)
 - The TriDAR sensor would be installed on the Orbiter to demonstrate technology for autonomous rendezvous and docking in low earth orbit
 - TriDAR would be mounted on the external airlock truss adjacent to Trajectory Control Sensor (TCS) 2 in the TCS 1 location (TCS 1 is no longer flown)
 - Hardware furnished by GFE and installed by Boeing tech orders
 - DMICB CRs were approved at 7/13/10 DMICB to authorize actions to protect for possible addition of TriDAR DTO
 - Revision of STS-335 flight products to add cabling / PAT box (CR M9316)

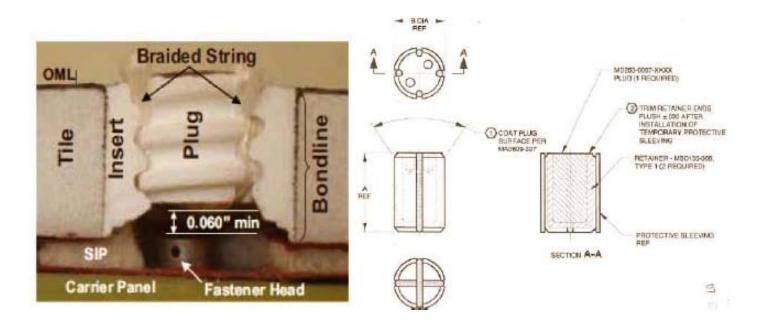

OMRS Limited Life/Time/Cycle & Interval Requirements

- Based upon a request at the STS-335 LSFR, a review of the OV-104 OMRS Limited Life/Time/Cycle & Interval Requirements thru January 21, 2012 was performed
 - The majority of the items reviewed could be worked in flow if required, or agreements to process exceptions are in place (see back-up)
 - 3 items were identified as long poles due to significant impacts to the processing flow if implementation were required
 - Remove and replace the Lower and Upper Hydrogen/Water Separator due 06/24/2011
 - NSLD is presently working spares to support the installation need date. Processing an OMRS exception will be considered if spares are unavailable
 - Remove and replace all 3 APUs due 09/07/2011
 - Presently this is a 6.5 year OMRS requirement. Potential for exception has been discussed based on the hardware being certified to 6 years 9 months
 - Retest FRCS and Pod Thrusters if it has been 18 months since last flight usage – due 11/14/2011
 - Requires pod removals and retest at the HMF

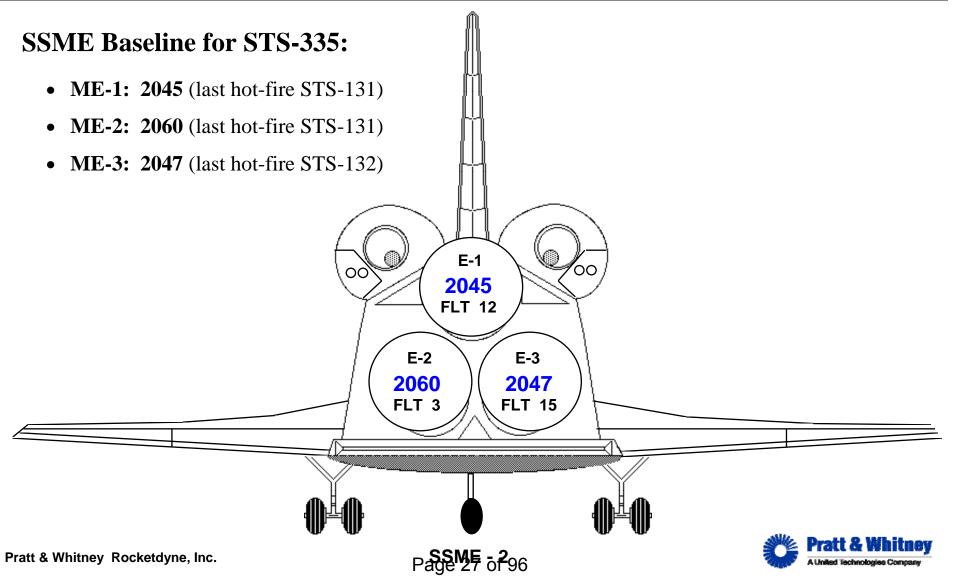

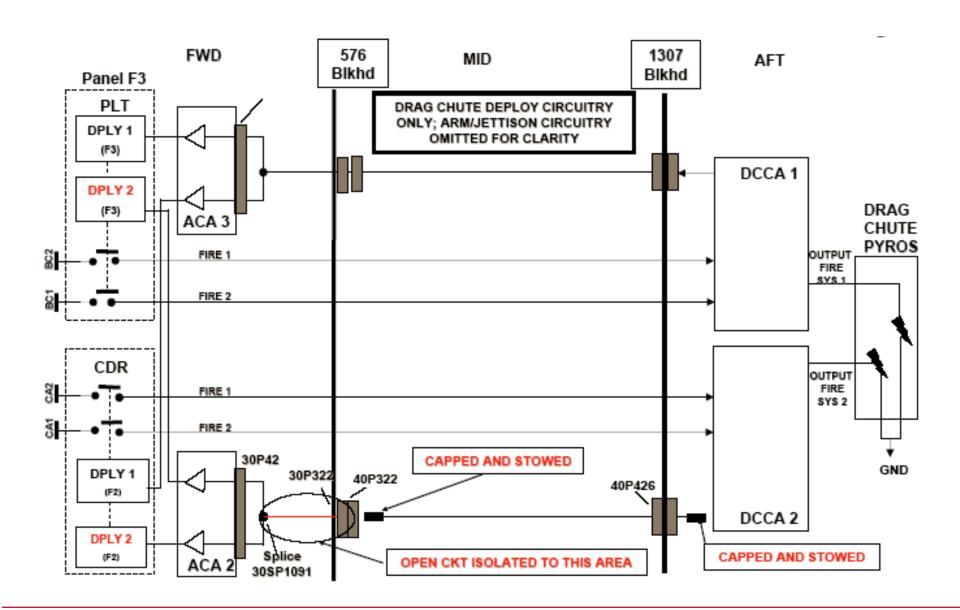
