Significant Changes Since Design Baseline

- Launch Date Updates
 - Moved from November 6, 2008 to December 4, 2008 to February 12, 2009
- Mission Duration updated from 13+1+2 to 14+1+2 Days
- Mated Beta Angle Constraint changed from 65° to 60°
- SSME Controller Mixture Ratio Software Update
 - Update implemented to correct LH/LOX mixture ratio shift observed in flight reconstruction
 - No impact to standard design process
 - Same implementation as STS-126
- Stack Swap with STS-125
 - STS-125 stack is a better performing stack than STS-119 original stack
- Removed the GN2 offload due to APM gains from the Stack Swap
- Implemented Multi-Stage De-Orbit for contingency payload return cases



Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

- First Flight of DTO 854, Boundary Layer Transition (BLT) Flight Experiment
 - No issues for FDD with the experiment
 - Supported by the Entry GN&C Panel and the AEFTP
- First Flight of EMCC Linux Hardware
 - Tracking checkout of New Linux Hardware as non-standard open work
- DOLILU Block Update 2009.01
 - Networking hardware rack equipment (switches and routers) have been relocated in the MCC
 - End-to-end testing and ISVT testing have been completed with no issues.
- Permanent Runway at Edward's Air Force Base will be operational for STS-119
 - FAA plans to certify the MLS on both ends of the runway on January 16 18, 2009
 - The temporary runway Flight Rules will still be available in the Annex, if required.



Deviations, Exceedances and Anomalies

- Deviations/Exceedances
 - A Contingency Abort Black Zone (CABZ) assessment is not required.
 - Mass properties do not meet the CABZ assessment criteria of liftoff weight greater than 259,000 lbm and Xcg aft of 1115.0 in.
 - FRR cycle liftoff weight = 266,398 lbs. and Xcg = 1110.8 in.
 - No Dock PLS exceeds the Nominal End of Mission downweight limit by 1,836
 lbm
 - Preflight thermal analysis is not required
 - Real-time analysis will be performed if required
 - Mission-specific flight rule has been submitted
- No Significant ARs
- No NCRs or Open Risk Assessments



Deviations, Exceedances and Anomalies (concluded)

- Previous Mission Anomalies (STS-126)
 - TRS Backup Unexpected Shutdown (AR 075970)
 - Power cycling of failed Data Distribution Switch.
 - Memorandum of Agreement in work for coordination between Navigation and FSM.
 - Tracking as non-standard open work
 - Rendezvous Radar Issues
 - During undock the Ku Radar to provide corrupted, unusable data.
 - Suspected Shuttle hardware issue, no impact to STS-119
 - Rendezvous ONAVs were briefed on events during STS-126

Rescue Mission Status

- STS-127 has been designated as the LON flight for STS-119
- On January 23, 2009, the Program will decide whether STS-125 or STS-127 launches in May
 - If STS-127 launch date slips then MOD's flight production plan will continue to support a May launch date to protect an LON call-up
- All rescue mission-specific analyses will be performed after call-up

DM Flight Design and Dynamics (Trajectory Operations) Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

ISS Phasing Strategy

- 1/14/09 burn: Posigrade 9.8 fps (3.0 mps).
- 2/4/09 burn: Posigrade 5.2 fps (1.6 mps).
 - Burn combination designed to maximize consecutive launch opportunities with FD3 rendezvous capability for STS-119 as well as provide acceptable Progress 32P launch opportunities.

Reboost/Deboost Capability

- STS-119 JURe capability will be provided with the SM engines
 - Propellant available for one full burn and a second half burn
 - Takes 4 days to refill SM fuel tanks after a full burn
 - 2 days will provide enough fuel for half a burn
 - Full burn provides 25.5 fps delta velocity
- Mated Reboost being assessed
 - Not in timeline or prop budget
 - If prop becomes available and timeline supports (>FD9)



Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

Visiting Vehicle Traffic during STS-119

- Progress 32P Launch on 2/10/08; Dock on 2/13/08 (STS-119 FD2)
- Docking is ~ 8 hours prior to NC3 NC3 cannot be cancelled
- Pre-Day of Rendezvous relative motion analysis will include Shuttle, ISS, and Progress trajectories

Jettison of S6 Thermal Covers (4) on FD5 (end of EVA1)

- Same jettisons that occurred on STS-117/13A (S3/S4)
 - Covers re-entered within 10 days; tracked by USSTRATCOM
- TOPO jettison analysis shows safe long term relative motion with ISS
- Covers expected to be far in front at deorbit TIG no concern
- Orbit adjust planning will have to consider relative motion with thermal covers

SEITE/MAUI/SIMPLEX payload of opportunity

- 2nd flight for SEITE opportunity
- Lessons learned from STS-126 incorporated during a pre-coordination tagup with DoD representatives


