Launch hold capability inside of drainback is dependent upon actual DOL performance. Abort coverage has sufficient overlap from liftoff to MECO.

Significant Changes Since Design Baseline

- Launch date changed from April 23, 2009 to May 15, 2009 to June 13, 2009.
- Forward Reaction Control System (FRCS) load updated from minimum to midpoint
- Maximum Rendezvous Altitude update from 195 nmi to 191 nmi
- DOLILU Wind Change Redline update in work (ECD 4/28/09)
 - Data has been updated and redefined to reflect seasonal vs. annual variations
 - Reviewed at Ascent/Entry Flight Techniques Panel on 4/13/09
 - Approved at the SICB on 4/28/09
 - Change will be implemented by MSFC Natural Environments
- Due to new MPS Inventory (R0901S), DOL Flight Derived Dispersion updates and New DOLILU S9 Rule updates are in work (CR84799AW)
 - Reviewed at GNC/Loads Panel on 4/24/09
 - Final authorization will come from the SICB (05/05/09)
 - DOLILU process implementation to be completed by TCDT (5/25/09)



Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

- First flight using the new MPS Propellant Inventory R0901S for DOL Support
 - STS-400 will be the first flight to fly with the new MPS Propellant Inventory R0901S if call-up is required.
- Launch scheduled 6 days prior to a mated beta angle cutout
 - 60-degree mated operations beta angle cutout starting June 20th through July 11th (July 10th KSC), 2009.
- Propellant budgeted for Passive Thermal Control (PTC) attitude control at End Of Mission (EOM) through EOM + 2 days
 - Potential exceedance of 60-degree beta angle constraint post undock if launch occurs on June 16th through June 20th.



Deviations, Exceedances and Anomalies

Deviation / Exceedances

- A Contingency Abort Black Zone (CABZ) assessment is not required.
 - Mass properties do not meet the CABZ assessment criteria of liftoff weight greater than 259,000 lbm and Xcg aft of 1115.0 in.
 - FRR cycle liftoff weight = 264,163 lbs. and Xcg = 1111.0 in.

Previous Mission Anomalies (STS-119 and STS-126/OV-105)

- During STS-119 Entry, all 3 TACANs temporarily lost lock on Bearing measurements.
 - OV-105 is equipped with 3-string GPS and has no TACAN receivers
 - Not an issue for this flight.
- During STS-126 (OV-105) undock, Ku Radar provided corrupted, unusable data (IFA 003668)
 - Confirmed hardware issue
 - Unit has been replaced

- STS-128 will be ready to launch on 8/06/09, if required, with the cargo element installed
- All rescue mission-specific analyses will be performed after call-up

DM Flight Design and Dynamics (Trajectory Operations) Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

• ISS Phasing Strategy

- Use Progress mid ring thrusters with Progress on the nadir
- Max phasing capability is 0.5 mps
- Reboost placeholder on 6/3 (Currently targeted as 0 m/s)
- Currently there is no reboost required
- Consecutive launch opportunities with FD3 Rendezvous: 9 days (June 13-21)
- There is no JURe capability
- Jettison of JEM Thermal Covers (4-6) on EVA 1 through 3.
 - TOPO jettison analysis shows safe long term relative motion with ISS
 - Covers expected to be far in front by undock
 - Jettison on EVA 5 or within two days of undocking prohibited by Flight Rule
 - EVA 2 jettisons (2) will only occur if time limited for bagging them during the EVA



Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

• ANDE-2 Deploy

- Deployed at least 5.3 nm (10 km) below ISS No recontact issues with ISS
- Separates into 5 components after deploy
- Separation delta-v from Space Shuttle is 0.7 fps (Castor Cylinder) to 4.4 fps (Pollux cylinder)
- Minimum velocity is 0.6 fps assuming 1 spring failure
- Deploy will be performed in an attitude to provide a retrograde sep
- Will perform a burn after deploy to bring sep rate to at least 1 fps opening. Burn TIG selected at optimal time for combination with orbit adjust if required

DRAGONSAT Deploy

- Deployed at least 5.3 nm (10 km) below ISS No recontact issues with ISS
- Separates into 2 components after deploy
- Separation delta-v from Space Shuttle is 6.8 fps to 7.9 fps
- Deploy will be performed in an attitude to provide at least 3 fps retrograde opening rate

Non-Standard Open Work

- Nominal Undock with OBSS unstowed:
 - 10 FPS Sep-2 burn required for subsequent deploy ops.
 - OBSS will be unstowed, on the SRMS in the undock position
 - Previous Analysis for up to 5.6 fps +X, ER verbally OK'd 10 and promised documentation
 - Submitted CR to 2JA_C2-50 Nominal Undock with OBSS Unstowed
 - EA agreed on 10 fps, but wanted additional content added to the rule
 - Safety has raised concerns with the thoroughness of the documentation of the analysis
 - Currently re-structuring, attempting to make PCN1
 - Fallback plan would be to execute 2 consecutive 5 fps burns separated by 1 minute
- Soyuz Debris Avoidance Maneuver 2JA Stage
 - Timeline is same as Progress without matching unit but additional flexibility on Time of Ignition (TIG) due to crew involvement
 - OIP, Flight Rules, and Console Handbook updates submitted waiting approval
 - 4 to 7 day period between 33P Prop Purge and 18S Relocate where this capability would be prime for any debris avoidance maneuvers
