Significant Changes Since Design Baseline

- Launch date from July 30 to August 6 to August 7 to August 18, 2009
- Mission duration increased to 13+1+2 days with 3 EVAs on OV-103
- Consumables offloaded to increase APM
 - O2 offload of 450 lbm due to availability of SSPTS (CR in work to increase offload to 520 lbm)
 - N2 offload of 67 lbm implemented
- Rendezvous altitude reduced to 188 nmi to increase APM
- Implemented multi-stage deorbit for contingency return case
- Incorporated a 3-minute launch window for performance quoting
- New MPS inventory implemented



Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

First flight of OI-34 Flight Software

- BFS HUD Capability Updates
 - Incorporated runway length I-Loads, enabled BFS HUD deceleration command indication and added High G-load and Body Flap warnings to enhance crew situational awareness
 - Added BFS I-Loads to define the GPS high-rate update region and frequency to address the potential for BFS HUD data jumps near touchdown
- ENTRY TRAJ 1 Display Update
 - Implemented a display timing check to eliminate the blinking phugoid symbol
- HORIZ SIT Display Update
 - Changed display logic to "park" the HAC at the bottom of the display rather than redrawing at the vertical center of the display

New Roll Maneuver Q-Plane (CR #S052550PD)

- Scheduled for SICB approval on 7/14/09
- No concerns for Flight Design (data change only)



Deviations, Exceedances and Anomalies

Deviation / Exceedances

- Two contingency cases exceed the nominal EOM downweight limit
 - No pre-flight analysis is required
 - Exceedance has been documented in the Flight Rules Annex
- A Contingency Abort Black Zone (CABZ) assessment was performed.
 - Mass properties meet the CABZ assessment criteria of liftoff weight greater than 259,000 lbm and Xcg aft of 1115.0 in.
 - OCF cycle liftoff weight = 266,855 lbs and Xcg = 1119.0 in.
 - FRR cycle liftoff weight = 267,690 lbs and Xcg = 1117.7 in.
 - Assessment revealed increased 3-engine-out black zones compared to STS-114 baseline
 - Results were reviewed with Flight Director, Crew and Flight Manager
 - Do not plan to pursue any mitigation options



Deviations, Exceedances and Anomalies (continued)

Previous Mission Anomalies

- Previous mission (STS-125)
 - Entry tracking issues
 - White Sands (WSMR) radar track data software and refraction correction issues on orbits 182 and 183 have been resolved
 - Issues with Edwards landing radars at Vandenberg (VAFB) concerning acquisition data,
 VDHC biases, and erroneously flagged data have been resolved
 - Navigation visits to Dryden and Vandenberg were held during the week of June 22, 2009 to improve communications with the sites to help eliminate tracking issues in the future
- Previous flight of vehicle (STS-119)
 - TACAN bearing dropout
 - All 3 TACAN LRUs lost bearing data for approximately 30 seconds resulting in NAV EDIT TAC message
 - No dropouts occurred on range data
 - Suspected cause was reflection from the nearby TACAN building; however RF suppression efforts were not successful in eliminating bearing dropouts
 - No concerns for STS-128 since alternate TACAN data and GPS data are available, and nav state updates from the ground can be performed

NCR 015170 I-Load Delivery Error

STS-130 I-Load Discrepancy

- A non-optimal value for the OMS mass I-Load was submitted into the official I-Load database (STAR)
- The discrepancy was caught by Boeing during the Flight Readiness Verification (FRV) process
- The I-Load was updated in STAR prior to I-Load approval

No concerns for STS-128

- The Flight Design I-Load audit and Boeing FRV process confirmed that there were no issues with the STS-128 I-Loads
- The OMS mass I-Load is not recomputed in the Uplink or Day of Launch processes
