Significant Changes Since Design Baseline

- Mission Duration increase from 11+1+2 to 12+0+2
- Maximum Rendezvous Altitude decrease from 200 N.Mi. to 190 N. Mi.



Significant Mission Firsts and Unique Items

- Launch opportunities from 5/14 through 5/23, and 6/1 through 6/12
 - Launch cutout from 5/24 through 5/31
 - Avoids Dual Docked Operations (DDO) scenario with Soyuz 21S undock
 - Propellant was budgeted to protect for possible Dual Docked Operations (DDO) for 23S docking
 - DDO scenario for launch dates from 6/8 through 6/12
 - Mated Beta angle will be violated from 6/13 through 6/28

Special Topics

• Upgrade to TSEP v3.8.1

- Update was not approved by the Orbiter Configuration Control Board (OCCB) in time to support upgrade for STS-131
- Approved at the 3/23 OCCB for STS-132 and subs
- Will be tracked and completed as Non Standard Open Work (ECD 4/30/10)
- Kwajalein (KWAJ) C-band tracking support could become unavailable due to the Information Assurance (IA) policy in June 2010
 - DM has requested an extension of waiver to the IA policy
 - Navigation analysis has concluded that the impact to tracking would be minimal due to the loss of KWAJ

Special Topics (conc.)

White Sands Missile Range (WSMR) C-band tracking support

- 2 of 3 sites have been recertified based on successful testing on STS-130
 - Complies with the Flight Rule requirement for dual source tracking
- Post STS-130, a computer software fix has been implemented to provide the correct time tag for a midnight rollover date stamp issue
 - Required tests for HOLC, WSSC and WSMC have been scheduled for April 1st
 - Will be tracked and completed as Non Standard Open Work
 - If tests are successful, all three sites will be considered recertified with the latest version of the software.
 - Currently verifying with the Network that White Sands can revert to the STS-130 version of the software, if required.

ISS Phasing Strategy

- Two ISS Reboosts scheduled prior to STS-132
 - 4/24 9.8 ft/s (3 m/s)
 - 5/5 Small burn if required
 - Delta-v's will be updated after STS-131/19A docking
- Rendezvous altitude will be approximately190 nm.
- FD3 rendezvous 5/14 through at least 6/3
- Beta cutout 6/13-6/28 and 8/13-8/24
- Window open on small phase angle days limited by minimum of about 37 deg

Joint Underspeed Recovery Capability

- No capability for 5/14 Launch Date

Changes to the Go/No-Go for RPM

- Loss of 1 FxD jet caused the RPM to be no go because the loss the second FxD on the same side caused the rendezvous for that day to be lost
- PRCB has decided to accept the risk of losing the second FxD during the RPM
 - Window of exposure is small (~10 seconds at start of RPM)
 - Provided next day re-rendezvous capability exists
- Rules and procedures are updated
