COAS SUBTENDED ANGLE (DEG) VS RANGE (FEET)

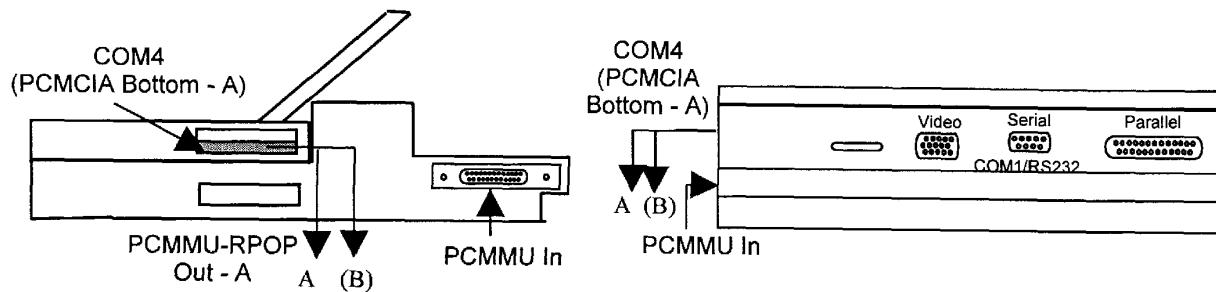
