HOFFMAN HOTEL

Daniel Hoffman built the Hoffman Hotel in 1852 at 131 West Main Street in Dallas across from the courthouse, shortly after the founding of the county. With 44 rooms, it was the largest and best known of several hotels where pioneer politicians, lawyers, judges, businessmen and farmers stayed while attending county court.

Rental Space Information

Gathering Room and Sun Porch

(Available only after operating hours)

A truly beautiful space for any event. The Gathering Room and Sun Porch offer 795 square feet of floor space that can accommodate 40 people for seated dinners or 100 people for a standing reception. This area looks onto the back lawn of the museum.



Bull Pen

(Available during /after operating hours)

The Bull Pen is a multi-purpose room that is ideal for luncheons, small receptions, meetings or retreats. This space can accommodate 50 people seated and 100 people standing. This space has a small room with sink and shelves and a bathroom as well. Hold your event here and relive history itself.



Museum Grounds

(Available only after operating hours)

The museum's grounds with tall trees, gardens, brick patio and walkway offers a quaint, natural setting for a day or evening outdoor event. Its uniqueness is the perfect setting for a wedding or that special event in your life with nature as its soundtrack. The grounds allow for a sit down event for up to 300 people and 600 people standing. The patio offers access to electrical outlets and lights, so it is a great place for entertainment.
