## Common Features of SNS's













- Personal space for posting PERSONAL information
- Mechanism to linking with other members
- Place to form Groups/Communities





### Pros:

- Lots of young members who haven't established "official" identities
- Many companies have a presence on these sites
- Great resource for finding friends links, and their comments
- Lots of info available without signing in

### Cons:

- Private pages
- Labyrinthine easy to get lost tracking friends, trying to read their pages

### Backdoor:

Google search and cache; Yahoo search and cache
